



## STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby commit myself to abide by the SANTS Student Code of Conduct in relation to my studies as a student at SANTS. I understand that I am preparing for my future role as a professional teacher.

I agree to:

1. Adhere to all rules, regulations and procedures as stipulated by SANTS;
2. Attend whenever possible the non-compulsory support sessions at designated venues that are indicated on my timetable. I understand that the venue is an environment conducive to learning where I will receive academic support, and to which I may submit hard copies of assignments on the dates set and within the submission time frame provided by SANTS. I further understand that the venue is not a satellite campus;
3. Submit my electronic assignments to SANTS Head Office via the email address given: [assignment@sants.co.za](mailto:assignment@sants.co.za); assignments must reach SANTS before or on the specific due date/s.
4. Take responsibility for my own learning and for the success of my studies;
5. Conduct myself in a disciplined manner during support sessions and WIL practical periods;
6. Abide by the rules of the support venue;
7. Take good care of my study material, as I will be held responsible for the cost of any replacement;
8. Treat with respect my tutor, fellow students, SANTS' staff, as well as the management and staff of the schools where I do my work integrated learning (WIL);
9. Strive to be well prepared for assessments;
10. Accept advice from my tutor, school-based mentor and SANTS' academic staff, as I understand that this will improve my practice as a teacher;
11. Understand that the support venue is hired by SANTS from the owner solely for the purpose of providing students with academic support on prearranged dates and can as such exclusively be used for this purpose by students who are registered for an official accredited SANTS programme. The conditions of usage of the SANTS venue are also subject to the accreditation conditions set out by the Council of Higher Education (CHE) and cannot be used for any other purpose;

12. Register with the South African Council for Educators (SACE) in my final year of study in order to become eligible for appointment as a teacher. I further agree that the arrangements and costs for this registration will be to my own account. I understand that I will NOT be able to obtain employment as a teacher if I am NOT registered with SACE on completion of my studies.
13. Ensure that all outstanding SANTS fees are paid on time; I acknowledge that no degree/diploma certificate will be issued to me before all outstanding fees have been paid.
